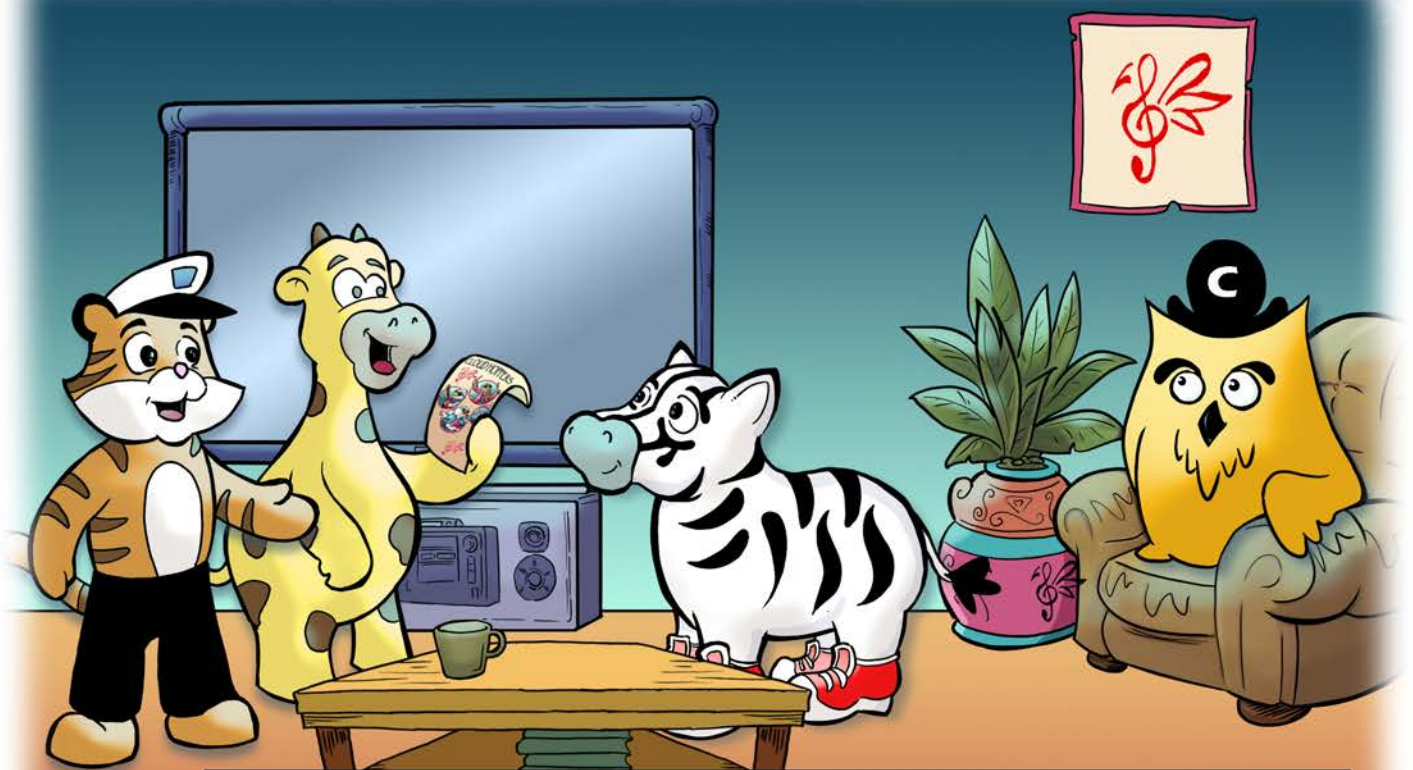
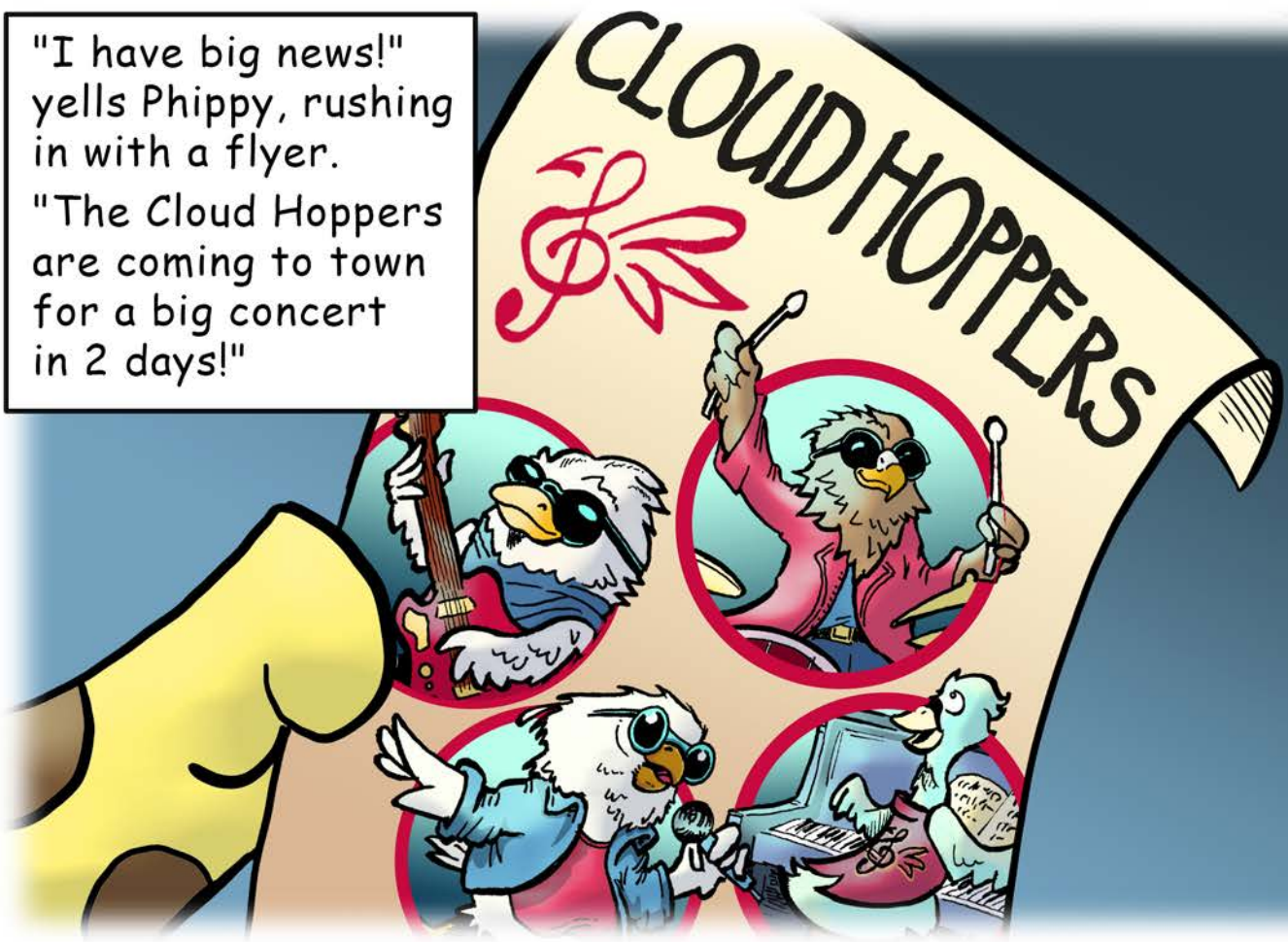
is the most unique way

The whole team rushes into the store, ready to pick their instruments.

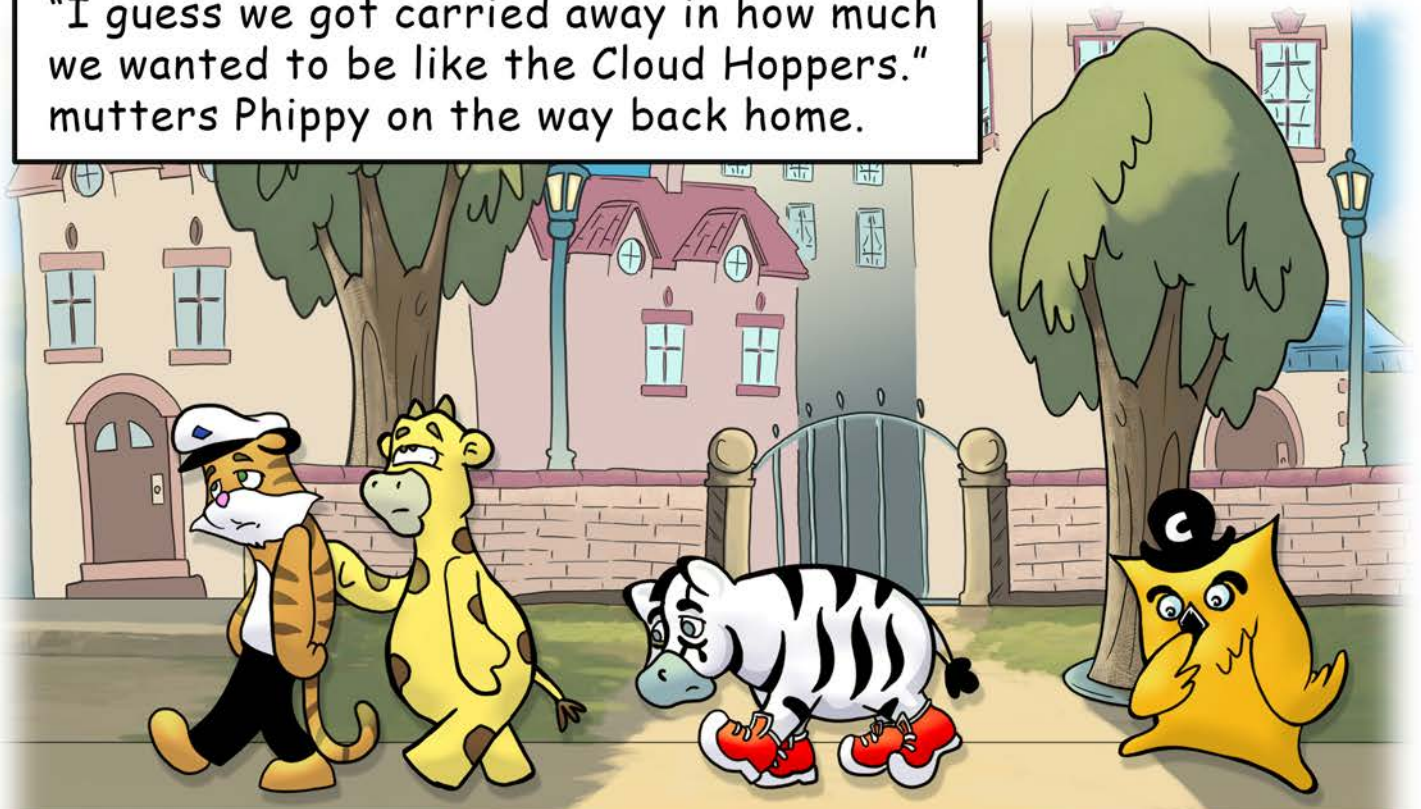




As they approach the register, Captain Kube realizes something. "Guys the concert is only in 2 days! That's not enough time to learn how to play those instruments."

My dear friends, I think we may have something here...

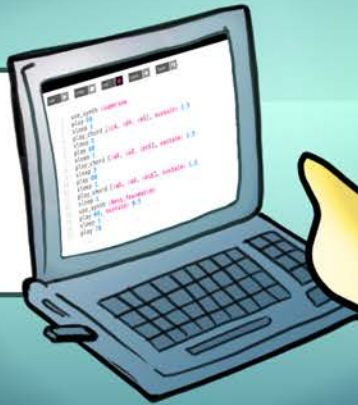


It is called SONIC PI and it could save our day! It allows us to turn code into music and is super easy to use!

As the concert is getting closer, Phippy and the rest of her friends become more familiar with Sonic Pi.

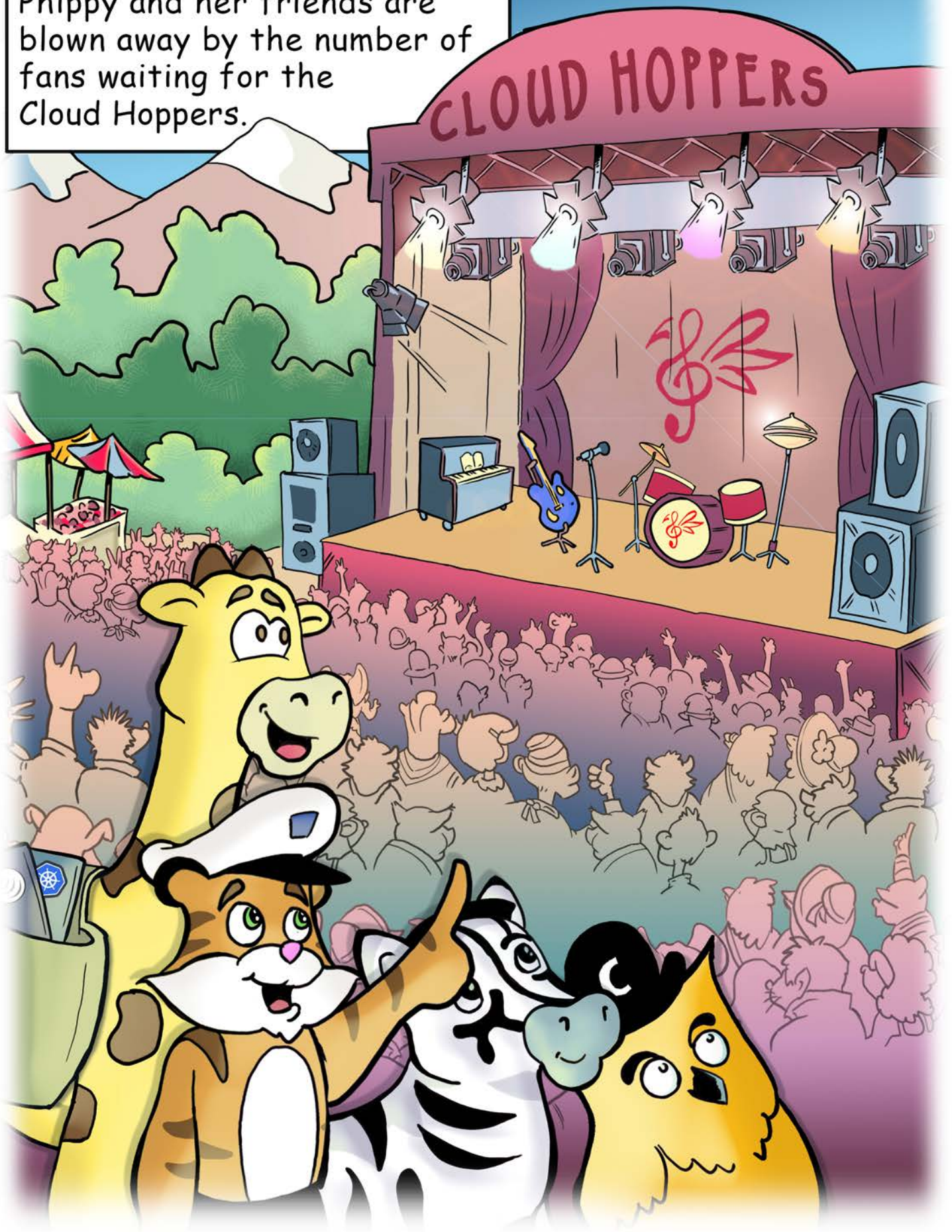
"You're right Captain, Sonic Pi is super easy to use!" says Phippy



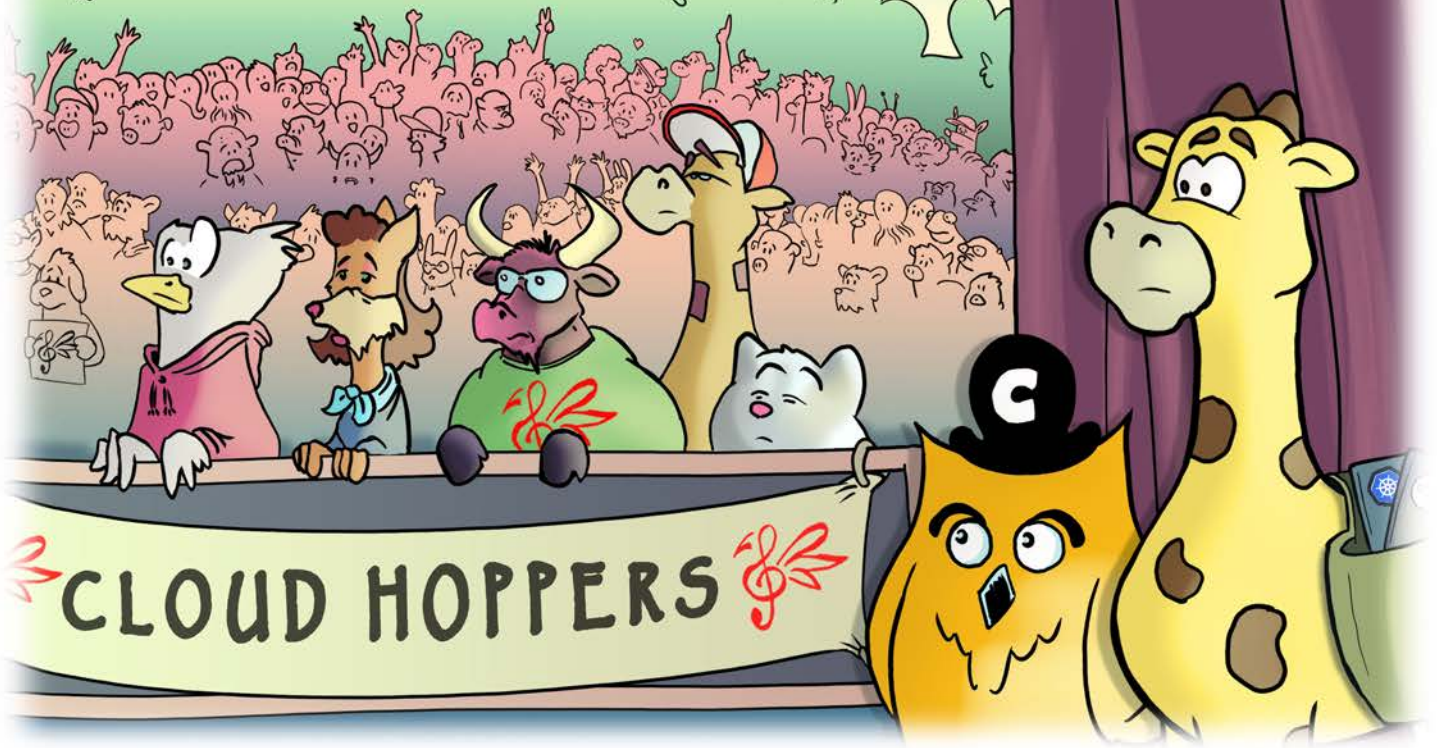
"It's time to show the Cloud Hoppers our new musical skills!"

the crowd is getting impatient...

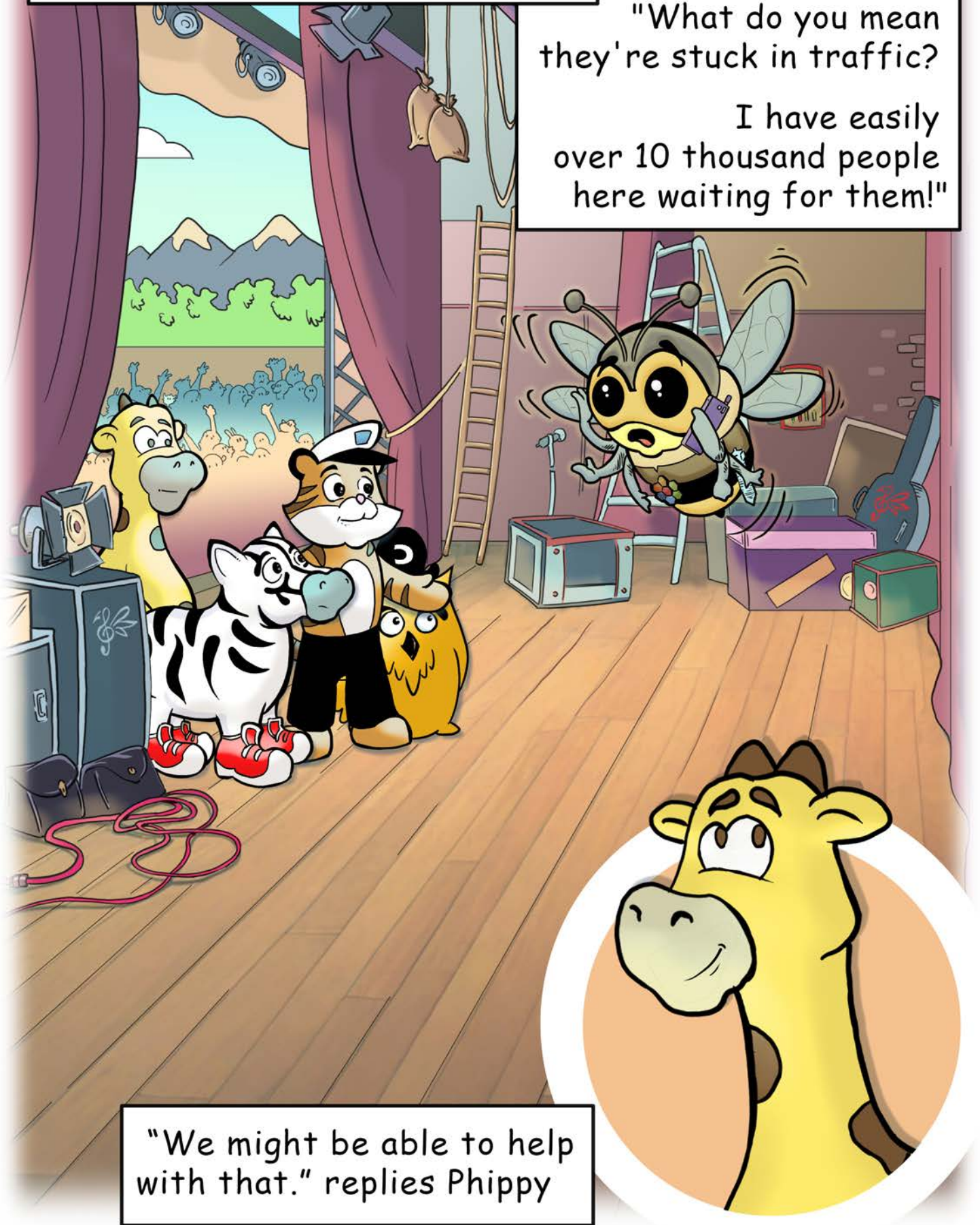


Phippy eventually decides to lead her team
